Master of Arts in Counseling

- (92-108 credits/Approx 3-4 years)
- · Start Quarters: Fall (October)
- Requirements: Bachelor's degree (any discipline), English Proficiency (TOEFL 87/IELTS 6.5)
- Emphasis Options: Marriage and Family Counseling, Mental Health Counseling, Addiction Counseling, School Counseling
- Core Classes: Multicultural Counseling, Career Counseling, Psychopathology, Psychopharmacology
- A clinical internship is required to complete this program, and is included in the course planning

- (39 Credits/18-24 Months)
- · Start Quarters: Fall, Winter, Spring, Summer
- Requirements: Bachelor's degree, Computer Science background (Computer Science degree preferred)
- Core Classes: Software Engineering, Cloud Computing, Managing Technology Projects, Information Security
- Conditional admissions available
- Pathway program for students without Computer Science background available

Intensive English Language Program

Tuition & Scholarships

CityU charges per credit – so the total tuition will depend on the number of credits required to complete a program.

New Students eligible for up to \$5,000 in scholarships

- CityU awards merit-based scholarships every year to high-achieving new international students
- Students with a GPA of 80% or higher upon their admission to CityU (calculated by CityU registrar) can receive from \$2,000-\$5,000 as a one-time tuition scholarship award.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Undergraduate:

- High School Diploma or equivalent
- · Proof of English proficiency
- At least one year of college-level coursework (45 quarter credits)

Graduate:

- Proof of English proficiency
- Bachelor's degree from an accredited or CityU recognized college or university

Document requirements:

- · Completed international student application form
- Non-refundable application fee
- · Photocopy of the picture page of the passport including expiration date
- Original or notarized copies of transcripts and diplomas confirming a bachelor's degree for admissions to graduate programs; original high school transcripts and diploma for undergraduate programs
- Proof of English language proficiency (e.g. TOEFL* or IELTS score report) if available
- Bank statement from student or sponsor showing sufficient funds to live and study in the U.S. (dated within nine months of intended start date)
- F-1 Student Financial Declaration
- · Sponsor statement confirming the annual amount of sponsorship, if applicable
- · Documentation for dependents, if applicable
- Transfer students currently in the United States will also need to submit:
 - Transcripts from all previously attended institutions of higher education. Certified English translations are required if the educational documents are issued in a language other than English.
 - International Student Transfer Evaluation Form
 - · Photocopies of previous I-20 forms
 - Copy of Visa page with arrival stamp
 - Photocopies of any other employment authorization or change of status notices issued by USCIS, if applicable
